



Global Competition Entry Guidelines

Welcome to this year's ELT Teacher Award, we look forward to receiving your submission but before you make your video, follow our checklist to make sure your entry has a winning chance!

Here's a simple checklist to make sure you have everything covered...

- Prepare your answers to the two questions before filming
- Set up your camera in a quiet and well-lit space so that we can ideally see your head and shoulders
- Practice filming your answers so you feel comfortable you have answered both questions
- Make sure you film in a quiet place and the audio is clear - we need to be able to hear you clearly
- Only film yourself and don't include any pictures of students
- Make sure your film is no more than 2 minutes long with each answer weighted as equally as possible, ie. one minute per question
- Set-up a private YouTube account so your video ISN'T visible to everyone
- Take a look at the [YouTube regulations](#) to make sure your video complies with their regulations

- Upload your video entry to a private YouTube channel
- Select your category and fill in your details on the online form
- Copy and paste the link of your private video on the online form
